Insurance Update



Work Update: The Association will begin complete siding replacement on the following eight buildings this summer/fall: 1 (1034-1044 Hinswood), 2 (1046-1054 Hinswood), 3 (8301-8309 Sweetwater), 4 (8291-8297

Sweetwater), 5 (8294-8302 Sweetwater), 6 (8304-8310 Sweetwater), 24 (1037-1047 Hinswood), and 25 (1027-1035 Hinswood).

Project Notes:

Important note for all owners: A project of this size will have various factors and unforeseen issues. One thing we have noted in pre-construction meetings is that some owners have wiring run on the outside of the building. We recommend that all owners review the outside of their units, particularly owners in phase one listed above. Owners with wiring run on the outside should meet with a qualified company to properly run all wiring through the walls. If a circumstance is presented where this is not possible, a variance form must be submitted for review by the board. Please understand that long stretches of wiring should have never been run outside the building and if applicable, this is the time to have it addressed.

Insurance Update:

The Association has retained an attorney and a public adjuster to assist us as we navigate this complex issue. In summary, the eight buildings noted were approved by insurance for replacement. Other buildings were not approved. The Association did not find this acceptable and we are working to have this resolved using a team of professional advisors. We appreciate everyone's patience.

Common requests include: window/door replacements and landscaping additions. The only exceptions are flowers in the mulch beds; **EVERYTHING** else needs prior Board approval. If you are contemplating making changes to your unit that impact the exterior, please contact the management office first with details of your plan. Thanks for your cooperation.

Please save yourself the expense and hassle by clearing any major changes with management first.

Upcoming Observances

Labor Day (Monday, September 5, 2022):

Labor Day is on the first Monday of September every year. It was originally organized to celebrate various labor unions' strengths of and contributions to the United States' economy. Labor Day is a day of rest or the last chance for many people to go on trips before the summer ends. For students, it is the last chance to organize parties before school starts again. In some neighborhoods, people organize fireworks displays, barbecues and public arts or sports events. The American football season starts on or around Labor Day and many teams play their first game of the season during Labor Day weekend.

Patriot Day (Sunday, September 11, 2022):

Patriot Day is an annual observance on September 11 to remember those who were injured or died during the terrorist attacks in the United States on September 11, 2001. Many Americans refer to Patriot Day as 9/11 or September 11. On the direction of the President, the flag of the United States of America should be displayed on the homes of Americans, the White House and all United States government buildings in the whole world. The flag should be flown at half-staff as a mark of respect to those who died on September 11, 2001. Many people observe a moment of silence at 8:46 AM (Eastern Daylight Time). This marks the time that the first plane flew into the World Trade Center. Some communities, particularly in the areas directly affected by the attacks, hold special church services or prayer meetings. Those who personally experienced the events in 2001 or lost loved ones may lay flowers or visit memorials.
